A most difficult time! Our High School students did not come back nor

were there new ones added (7 remain for 8 teachers). Second, the **School Fees Paid** was up by 19% but the **Intl. donations off** by 46% or a net difference (loss) of \$23,861. Van/Bus transport costs were double

Van expenses the 14,000,000 (excluding driver

and investment depreciation). Expenses exceeded last year by 11% mostly due to inflation (now at 21% annually). Food costs have increased by 20% even with a smaller (5%) student body (and continue to). Orphans on sponsorship are 69, with 11 school funded and 9 were new sponsorships. **Up** was the **FEE income** but **Expenses exceeded them by \$20,000** most of which was supplied from personal funds, as the fund drive netted only \$1,200 out of the \$20,000 needed for the First term. **Academics** were poor in the first half, but with the elimination of “extra-curricular activities” performance significantly improved. Excellent students were rewarded with a day at the beach.

Sponsorship included 9 new kids, and a family support donation (food for Shirat’s single mother, whose shop was burned down in Kampala in a major fire where thousands lost jobs, shop and inventory). Marla had to supply many uniforms to orphans and new students; 69 are under full sponsorship. *“Whatever happens, my dear brothers and sisters, rejoice in the Lord. I never get tired of telling you [of] these things . . .” Phil 3:1 NLT*

Transport included service for 46 kids but the income did not offset the costs (\$135/student/term in costs vs. \$75/s/t income). The “expense cause” was our “aging VAN”. I am looking for a **new(er) VAN (Japan)** to replace ours and have sold my personal car in the USA to help fund the purchase thus reducing repair costs. We can use your help (cost \$15,000 plus \$7,500 in Taxes).

Spiritual life was enhanced by a new English teacher Gabriel, who is also a Baptist Evangelist. He joined the church and now we share God’s word with Pastor Hubert, Pastor Gabriel, and still have Pastor Deus to do Catechism. Now two community members have joined the church in Term 1, while (during school session) 50-75 attend Church each Sunday.

From the 200 students and 30 staff, greetings and thanksgiving to God for your loving help, as we paid up the electric bill, started Day Care, Cooking classes, and helped community members with food and medical bills. We are saddened by the loss of Pastor Hubert’s mother in law (in Rwanda), our matron Maria’s “cousin-brother”, the collapse of Deputy Geoffrey’s mother’s house (she got a broken leg during the storm) and many other hardships. They need your special prayers.
